WHAT IS A ZERO WASTE EVENT?

Zero Waste Events are defined as events producing 10% or less of landfill waste. This means 90% or more waste produces must be either composted or recycled. Another great focus on zero waste is taking what

AFTER THE EVENT

Collect and store any items that can potentially be used at a future event

- o Collect name badges for reuse
- o Collect banners, decorations, unused utensils
- o Have collection bin for unwanted promotional items
