

Terminal Degree Fellowship

INTRODUCTION:

The Office of Graduate Studies is committed to supporting students enrolled in doctoral and terminal degree programs at Towson University. The purpose of the Towson University Graduate Student Fellowship program is to advance the excellence of graduate students. The fellowship includes a tuition waiver (for up to six credits per semester) and a \$3000 stipend.

Fellowships are awarded to students on the basis of (a) the scholarly merit of their work, and (b) the potential for the fellowship to enhance their professional experience. Each graduate program may nominate one student for consideration per academic year, and a maximum of one student per program will receive the award each year. Contingent upon available funds, the Office of Graduate Studies will award a maximum of five fellowships per academic year, such that not every program will have an award recipient. Priority will be given to students who are working on their dissertation/thesis requirements for graduation as substantiated by their advisor or program director and/or have not received the fellowship previously.
