

Postdoctoral Scholar

Consider hiring a Postdoctoral Scholar (postdoc) on your externally funded sponsored research/grant to:

1. Advance the scholar's career and training goals
2. Enhance the University's research community through mentorship and education.

These positions will be considered TU employees and receive benefits determined by their employment classification. TU conforms to NIH guidance for budgeting postdocs on sponsored programs/grants with external funds.

NIH/NSF definition of a postdoctoral scholar:

An individual who has received a salary

The salary information below is effective for FY24 according to the federal fiscal year (October 1, 2023-September 30, 2024) and can be used until further notice. The OSPR will update this guidance annually as this link will change.

Salary ranges from Postdoc 0 – Postdoc 7+: \$61,008 – \$74,088 annually which can be divided into monthly amounts. Salary level may be determined by experience, qualifications, performance, available
