

## ELEMENTARY EDUCATION & SPECIAL EDUCATION DUAL CERTIFICATION PROGRAM EESE Campus Students

The EESE program is a screened major. Qualifications for admittance include a minimum of 3.0 on all prerequisite coursework required for the major. A GPA of at least a 3.0 in the major is required for entering the final internship. Students who have earned less than a 3.0 cumulative GPA at the elimination of the final semester of the program will be required to take the Praxis Core for certification. All prerequisite, Core and professional program courses require a final grade of a 2.0 or higher. Students are responsible for ensuring that they meet the prerequisite content area curriculum requirements of the university.
